



## **RASE welcomes the Kenilworth Show to Stoneleigh**

The Royal Agricultural Society of England has announced that it will host the 67<sup>th</sup> Kenilworth Show on Saturday 5 June 2010.

Since the RASE announced that the 2009 Royal Show would be the last, Stoneleigh Park has hosted a wide variety of agricultural and commercial events, but is particularly pleased to be welcoming on site the Kenilworth Show, organised annually by The Kenilworth and District Agricultural Society.

Commenting on the move, the RASE's Chief Executive Brian Warren said: "Everyone at the RASE and many in the surrounding area were sad to see the end of the Royal last year, so we are delighted that we will be able to welcome back livestock and agricultural entertainment to Stoneleigh. The event fits perfectly with our core charitable purpose and we are very pleased to be able to support our local Show."

Set to attract thousands of people from across the county, the traditional country show will be held on a 50 acre site directly opposite the main entrance to Stoneleigh Park. The show will feature agricultural and equestrian classes and a wide range of homecraft competitions, trade stands and various other activities for the whole family.

Organising committee chair Cynthia Mold said she was delighted with the new venue and confident it would prove popular: "The site opposite Stoneleigh Park is a really great location, close to Kenilworth, Leamington and Coventry and we are really pleased to have secured it for this year's event."

"We will have the use of three large fields for all the exhibitions and events and the site also benefits from great access and plenty of free car parking for visitors.

"We would like to thank Tom Steele for accommodating us for the past 10 years, but this is a new chapter for the Kenilworth Show and we hope everyone in the county will come out and support the event."
